DOUG KLIER APPOINTED TO SEAT ON LAKE ADAMHS BOARD

Painesville, OH -- Douglas Klier was appointed to a four year term on the Lake County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board. Klier was sworn in during the Board's regular March, 2012 meeting.

Established by Ohio Statute, ADAMHS Boards are responsible for planning, funding and evaluating local mental health and addiction recovery services. In Lake County, those services are delivered through a network of providers – Neighboring, Crossroads, Pathways, Signature Health, Lake-Geauga Recovery Centers, and others. Board members, 18 Lake County residents who serve without compensation, are appointed by either the Ohio Department of Mental Health, the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services, or the Lake County Commissioners. By statute, Board members include mental health and addiction recovery experts, consumers (people who need and use services), family members of consumers, and community leaders.

Klier is a therapist as well as a Registered Nurse. He is currently employed by Premier Behavioral Health Services and Hillcrest Hospital. He also has experience in management and quality assurance functions relative to behavioral health providers. The Willoughby resident was appointed to the ADAMHS Board by the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services.
