

ISSUE 3 NEEDS AND DESERVES YOUR SUPPORT!

Issue 3 is a 0.7 mill renewal levy that funds critical mental health and addiction recovery services in Lake County.

WHO: The Lake County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board.

WHAT: A 0.7 mill renewal levy. Voters first approved this levy in 1989.

WHEN: May 8, 2018

SIGNIFICANCE: *The levy is lifeblood for our system.* It funds prevention and education efforts relative to the opiate epidemic, and treatment and support for people and families struggling with mental illness and/or substance use disorders. Other local initiatives supported by this levy include the ADAMHS Board's Compass Line, Trauma Response Team, Opiate Task Force, Crisis Hotline, Suicide Prevention Coalition, and trainings that help police, fire and other first-responders react safely and effectively when they encounter mental illness symptoms on the job.

THE NEED: Demand for services is increasing, and federal and state funding is shrinking. The passage of this levy will allow our system to continue its support of critical local services.

COST: *Issue 3 is not a new tax. There is no increase in millage.* Annual cost to Lake County homeowners for this levy is, and will continue to be, \$21.44 per \$100,000 of home valuation.
