

LAKE ADAMHS ELECTS OFFICERS FOR UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR

During the June 15, 2020 annual meeting of the Lake County ADAMHS Board a new slate of officers were elected for State Fiscal Year 2021 which begins July 1.

Established by Ohio Statute the Alcohol, Drug Addiction, and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board is responsible for planning, monitoring, evaluating, and funding services for Lake County residents who are dealing with mental illness and/or addiction disorders. Services are delivered by a network of provider agencies.

The new officers include:

DavidENZERRA, Chair

ENZERRA is a long-time member of the ADAMHS Board and has served on its Executive, Long-Range Planning, and Program Committees. The Painesville resident is retired from Lubrizol Corporation, where he held multiple and diverse senior leadership roles.

AndrewMEINHOLD, Vice-chair

MEINHOLD has been a board member since 2017. The Concord Township resident retired from nearly 40 years in the banking industry including a stint as President/CEO of Lake National Bank. He has served on multiple committees including chairing the Allocation Committee.

MattSABO, Treasurer

SABO is Chief of the Concord Township Fire Department. He has been an ADAMHS Board member since 2018, and has served as chair for Evaluation/Quality Improvement Committee.

RobertaKALB, Secretary

KALB is a long-time board member who has served as board chair. Kalb has also been a member of all ADAMHS committees and has chaired several.

LesBECK, Past chair

BECK chaired the ADAMHS Board in SFY 2020. The past chair is automatically appointed to the following year's slate of officers. Beck has served on Allocation and Long Range Planning Committees.
